



## 2026 – 2027 Evaluation Rules

- All players trying out for a BWGMHA MD team must be registered and a member in good standing with BWGMHA.
- Tryout Passports for U7/U8/U9 is **\$TBD** – this includes a try out jersey.
- No Rep, AE or LL jerseys are to be worn by players during evaluations.
- Three evaluations are scheduled for each team.
- Players are eligible for release following the first evaluation.
- Players missing an evaluation must notify the coach and/or the VP of Operations a minimum of 24hrs prior to the tryout date. Players missing any evaluation must pay the full passport amount.
- Final selections and releases are to be completed, with parents notified, no later than midnight on the day of the last evaluation.
- The Coach reserves the right to release a player by November 15th
- Players selected will be required to sign a commitment letter and player code of conduct form confirming their selection and intent to play for the selected team for the coming season.
- Players/Parents who do not sign to the commitment letter and player code of conduct will not be rostered and risk full release from the team.

### Underage Eligibility

- Players wishing to try up must inform the coach and the VP of Operations their intent to do so at least 48hrs in advance of each evaluation.
- Players wishing to try up must try out for their own age group first unless the MD program is not being offered at their age group.
- Those players wishing to try up must pay an additional fee of **\$TBD** for their second evaluation unless the MD program is not being offered at their age group.
- Players trying up will be evaluated by a committee selected by the VP of Operations.

- The Player must be evaluated by the selection committee and identified as a “Top 5” player(s) at their position to be selected on the team. Goalies are approved on a per case basis by the Board.
- Once an under-aged player has been selected on a team they are considered “grandfathered” and may continue to play for that team in following season(s) pending Hockey Canada Player Pathway eligibility.
- Final roster decisions on underaged players are subject to review and approval of the BWGMHA Board.
