



Tournament Information House League, Local League, Select & MD

Welcome to the Bradford Bulldogs Blue & Gold Classic Hockey Tournament in Bradford, Ontario. Most games will take place at the Bradford Leisure Centre, Bob Fallis Recreation Centre in Bradford & the Centre Ice Sportsplex @The Nottawasaga Resort in Alliston. Other games could also be played at other nearby arenas. ALL DIVISIONS ARE NON CONTACT!

All teams must register at arena of your first game with official roster & travel permit. If you can send roster & permits by email in advance of tournament this is also accepted & recommended.

We schedule tournaments based on where teams reside. We will do our best to schedule all or most of your games at arena closest to your hotel. For teams staying at one of the Resorts above we will try & schedule games approximately 3 hours apart to maximize your Resort stay!

Format of Tournament

- Maximum of 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 12 teams per division. **Each team is guaranteed 3 games.** Maximum of 17 players and 2 goalies may be registered per team. A maximum of 17 players plus 2 goalies can be dressed per game. Players can only register & play in one division.
- In the 3 team division each team will play 2 games. After the 2nd game the team that finishes 1st will get a bye to the final. The 2nd & 3rd place team play a semi final. Winner of semi final plays 1st place team in championship.
- In the 4 team division a round robin format will be done. The top 2 teams after the 3 games will play in the Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 5 team division all teams will have 3 games except one random team will have a 4th game. The 4th game for the random team will not count for any stats but the team they are playing will count for them as this would be their 3rd game. The top two teams will play in the Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 6 team division after all teams have played 3 games, the top 2 teams will play in Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 6 team Minor Bantam RS division after all teams have played 3 games, the top 2 teams in each Tier will play in Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 7 team division after all teams have played 2 games, teams will be seeded from 1st place to 7th place. The 1st place team will get a bye to semi final. **Quarter Final** games would be: The 2nd place team plays 7th place team, the 3rd place team plays 6th place team & 4th place team plays 5th place team. **Semi Finals** 1st place team plays winner of 4th vs 5th & winner of 3rd vs 6th plays winner of 2nd vs 7th. Winners of semi final games will play in Championship Final Sunday afternoon
- In the 8 team division there will be (2) divisions of 4 teams, with the top 2 teams in each division advancing to a semi final. Winner of Pool I will play 2nd place team in Pool II. 2nd place team in Pool I will play winner of Pool II. Winners of semi finals will play in Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 10 team division all teams will be grouped into 1 pool of 10 teams. The top 4 teams will advance to a semi final game: 1st vs 4th, 2nd vs 3rd. Winners of semi final games play in finals.
- In the 11 team division there will be (2) divisions of 6 & 5 teams, with the top 2 teams in each division advancing to a semi final. Winner of Pool A will play 2nd place team in Pool B. 2nd place team in Pool A will play winner of Pool B. Winners of semi finals will play in Championship Final Sunday.

- In the 12 team division the top team in each pool will advance to a semi final along with 1 wild card team with the next best overall record. Winners of semi final games will play in Championship Final Sunday.
- In the 14 team division there are 2 divisions of 4 teams & 1 division of 6 teams. The top team in Pool A & Pool B & top 2 teams in Pool C advance to the semi finals. 1st semi final is 1st in Pool A vs 1st Pool C. 2nd semi final is 1st Pool B vs 2nd Pool C. Winners play in Championship Final
- In the 16 team division there are 4 divisions of 4 teams. The top team in Pool A, Pool B, Pool C & Pool D advance to the semi finals. 1st semi final 1st in Pool A vs 1st Pool C. 2nd semi final is 1st Pool B vs 1st Pool D. Winners play in Championship Final

FURTHER INFORMATION

- Teams MUST present signed Approved Roster Sheets & Travel Permits or letter of permission.
- A member of the coaching staff will be required to register 60 minutes before 1st game & 45 minutes prior to other games.
- Tournament Committee will designate home teams
- Home teams will wear a light colour jersey. If a conflict arises regarding jersey colours, the VISITING team will change jerseys.
- Players & Coaches must be in their dressing rooms 30 minutes prior to their game time.
- Teams must be ready to play up to 15 minutes prior to their scheduled time.
- Dressing rooms must be vacated within 20 minutes of game completion.
- A 3 minute warm-up will be allowed after the ice is cleaned. Clock will be start at 13 minutes. At the 11 minute mark, **TIMEKEEPER WILL BUZZ CLOCK & TEAMS WILL HAVE ONE MINUTE TO GATHER PUCKS. CLOCK WILL STOP AT THE 10 MINUTE MARK BEFORE GAME STARTS**

- Friday Games can start at 9:00 AM. Out of town teams will get preference for later Friday game starts. Some teams may play 2 games on Friday.

- Most games at Resort but some games could also be played at nearby arenas within 20 minutes pending total number of teams registered.
